Kitchen worktops are made from many different materials, available in different colours and different prices. If we look at each of the main types on the market, it will explain how important designer concrete will become over the next few years

Laminate is the most ready available and the most reasonably priced.



og Furniture

This is a laminate sheet most commonly attached to a chipboard core. It can peel, burn or even melt; it is easy to scratch and can become non-antibacterial.

Hardwood is the next expensive. It is only available in a limited range of colours (natural wood colours). It needs regular maintenance and can stain, especially near a source of water such as a sink.


Granite is also restricted to natural colours. It is quarried in certain areas in the world and comes in sheets that are cut and polished to size, so there is inevitably some waste.

Quartz is the next step: natural quartz is mixed with a percentage of resin. Quartz is also quarried in certain areas of the world and comes in sheets, which are cut and polished to size so there is inevitably waste. The resin is a man-made additive. This product is available in varied colours, but these are restricted to what manufacturers want to produce.

Designer concrete or GFRC concrete may well hold all the answers to the restrictions of the other materials, and is available in any colour and any shape. The cost is similar to that of quartz and granite.

However, a GFRC worktop is made by hand for each customer with minimal waste. It mainly consists of sand and limestone, two of the most abundant materials on the planet. It is hard wearing, antibacterial, does not scratch easily, and will last a lifetime. As you can see from the photographs, designer concrete can be made into furniture, such as tables, or sinks in bathrooms, as well as the perfect worktop for any kitchen.
